PROMOTING COUNTRY DIALOGUE

Within the framework of the identification mission carried out in Honduras in 2017, where the programme met with 20 institutions, the country presented the EUROsocial+ Programme with a total of 11 requests for support in its public policies (actions), of which three are currently being supported. It is expected that the first country round table will be held in 2020.

COUNTRY PLANNING

Honduras's Country Vision 2010-2038 plan has been implemented through the establishment of 17 guiding principles for development, four national objectives and 22 national priority goals. It also has its Nation Plan 2010-2022, which contains 11 strategic guidelines for achieving the Country Vision. Finally, there are the Government Plans, which cover four-year periods and which chart the government's efforts to achieve short-term goals.

Area: Democratic Governance Policies

Line of action: Access to justice

We are supporting the implementation of the “100 Brasilia Rules on Access to Justice for People in Vulnerable Conditions”, through technical advice on the design and development of institutional policies and their promotion, dissemination, understanding, application and incorporation a cross-cutting priority in the approval and execution of programmes and projects that guarantee access to justice in Honduras.

Line of action: Good governance

At the multi-country level, work is being undertaken together with Uruguay and El Salvador to generate a Municipal Management Model on Transparency and Access to Public Information, whose different dimensions are aimed at increasing compliance with laws on access to public information in the municipalities of the participating countries. A diagnosis on municipal transparency has been carried out and a model is being designed to improve the current situation.



Area: Social policies

Line of action: Active Employment Policies

The Government of Honduras, through the Ministry of Employment and Social Security, is promoting an initiative to reform the current professional training and capacity-building system. The objective of the reform is to create conditions based on equal opportunities that ensure that the workforce has an adequate level of education, technical training and professional training that correspond to labour market needs. In order to nurture the technical and political discussion on professional training and skill-building in Honduras and support the reform proposal, it is necessary to refer to similar processes developed in other countries. Within this framework, EUROsociAL+ support will focus on facilitating the relationship between these reform experiences and the lessons and inputs that come from them and their incorporation into the ongoing process in Honduras. Two technical assistance missions have been carried out to assess the situation regarding vocational training in Honduras and the scope of the reforms promoted by the government and to define with the Ministry of Employment an operational strategy to advance the comprehensive reform of the EFTP in line with international standards. As of January 2020, we have resumed our support for the formulation of the national education and professional technical training policy, regulatory development of the national qualifications framework and structure of the national qualifications catalogue and assistance with the process to reform National Institute of Vocational Training (INFOP).

SHARING EXPERIENCES

Honduras participates in the EUROsociAL+ Programme as a transferring agent of its good institutional practices, together with El Salvador, with the Trifinio Plan for regional development.

- ▶ Latin America Fiscal Education Network, implementing the Accounting and Tax Assistance Hubs (NAF).
- ▶ International Taxation Network at the Inter-American Tax Administrations Centre (CIAT).
- ▶ Participating in the following actions with the Ibero-American Association of Public Prosecutor's Offices (AIAMP): strengthening cooperation in the fight against corruption by the Anti-Corruption Network of the AIAMP and institutional strengthening to combat the differentiated impacts of corruption on women through the Specialist Group on gender issues.
- ▶ Collaborative implementation of the Document Management Model and the promotion of open legislation in Latin America in the Transparency and Access to Information Network (RTA) as well as in the action on the gender perspective in transparency and access to public information policies in Latin America.
- ▶ Implementation of the New Brasilia Rules at the Latin American level and the improvement in access to justice for vulnerable populations in the Ibero-American Region, through the Ibero-American Judicial Summit (CJI).
