EUROsocial+ started the dialogue with Chile in 2016. A total of 15 public institutions were visited, identifying a portfolio of actions that have been undertaken. After the change of government in March 2018, a mission was carried out in May 2019, this time to prepare a future country dialogue round-table, where the programme was made known to the new authorities, the current portfolio reviewed and the possibility of dialogue with other actors explored.

## Area: Gender Equality Policies

### Line of Action: Violence; sexual and reproductive health; and concepts of masculinity

Incorporation of an evaluation methodology to introduce the gender perspective into the prosecution of violent crimes for the Public Prosecutor's Office. Reinforcement of the training plan for public agents on forms of gender violence against women, accompanying the Ministry of Women and Gender Equity.

### Line of Action: Economic autonomy and care

We contribute to disseminating good labour practices regarding gender equality in SMEs together with the Ministry of Women and Gender Equity.

### Line of Action: Transversality, budget and statistics

Technical assistance for designing the Public Prosecutor's Office's Gender Policy and a Good Practice Booklet for incorporating the gender perspective into the judiciary.



## Area: Democratic Governance Policies

### Line of Action: Public Finances

Implementation of anti-tax evasion regulations and qualification of territorial tax management.

### Line of Action: Regional Development

Design of institutional architecture for the multi-level management of territories and the implementation of regional secretariats.

### Line of Action: Access to justice

Design and implementation of defence protocols for migrants and foreigners; specialist defence for women deprived of freedom Implementation of SIRCAVI. Support for reforms: for juvenile restorative justice; the local civil procedure; and the national policy on access to justice. Design of models: health care for people deprived of liberty; and care for victims and witnesses.

### Line of Action: Good governance

An Anti-Corruption Legal Assistance Centre (ALAC) has been created and a whistleblower protection system is being promoted.



## Area: Social Policies

### Line of Action: Policies of social inclusion and the fight against poverty

We support the Solidarity and Social Investment Fund (FOSIS) in developing methodological instruments to apply the intercultural approach in managing social programmes with migrant populations in vulnerable territories.

### Line of Action: Active Employment Policies

We support the installation of competence certification programmes for the migrant population National Training and Employment Service (SENCE).

### Line of Action: Policies for youth, adolescence and childhood

We support Chile Crece Contigo ("Chile Grows with You")—the social protection system from the Undersecretary of Childhood, in the Ministry of Social Development—in strengthening its programmes and services, by means of a comprehensive evaluation, an improvements plan and evaluation methodologies and indicators.

## SHARING EXPERIENCES

Chile participates in the EUROsocial+ Programme as a transferring agent of its good institutional practices, among which the following stand out: the Prevalence of Gender Violence Survey; the intervention system to combat gender centric violence based on work with male aggressors; the monitoring systems of public policies to eradicate violence against women; Transparency and access to information; education for democratic citizenship; ethics in public service; Regional Development Fund; promotion of youth employment; policies to fight poverty; registers of social programmes and social protection policies.
