Within the framework of the identification mission carried out in Ecuador in 2017, the country submitted a total of 55 requests to the EUROsociAL+ Programme for support in its public policies (actions). In March and June, a virtual pre-round table dialogue was held to identify demand and consolidate on-going actions.

Area: Gender Equality Policies

Line of Action: Violence; sexual and reproductive health; and concepts of masculinity

Within the framework of COVID-19, we are supporting the Judicial Council in measures to guarantee access to services for victims of gender violence.

The Judiciary is supported in implementing standards of care for victims of violence against women and members of the family core

We are providing assistance to construct the methodology for indicators in the National Survey on Gender Violence by the National Secretariat of Planning and Development. The objective is to obtain statistical data on the prevalence, incidence and magnitude of the different types of gender violence to report on indicators relating to the PND and SDGs.

Line of Action: Mainstreaming, budget and statistics

We are contributing to the implementation and decentralisation of the National Gender Equality Agenda of the National Council for Gender Equality, to enforce the principle of equality and avoid discrimination on the basis of gender in Ecuador.

The objective of the action is to incorporate gender equality policies into public sector plans, programmes and projects, by defining vertical mechanisms for coordination, implementation, monitoring and evaluation towards all the territories. Likewise, to encourage participation by women and LGBTBI people in the construction and territorial implementation of the ANI.



Area: Democratic Governance Policies

Line of Action: Regional Development

Support in consolidating the decentralisation processes and appropriate financing models, through tax optimisation at the subnational level. Also in elaborating the Intersectoral Agenda on the Sea (AIM) and in strengthening cross-border territorial development capacities.

Line of Action: Access to justice

Progress is being made in designing and implementing the Restorative Juvenile Justice System. The aim is to optimise the Restorative Juvenile Justice System to deal with criminal offences committed by adolescents in Ecuador. This project ranges from the diagnosis of the system to the formation of a training group for restorative juvenile justice trainers.

Line of Action: Good governance

Technical collaboration with the Ecuadorian National Electoral Council (NEC) in reforming the country's electoral code.



Area: Social Policies

Line of Action: Care policies

We are supporting the strengthening of the care policy from the Ministry of Economic and Social Inclusion (MIES). The objective is to build a National Care System with a public policy proposal that seeks to recognise and guarantee unpaid human care work as productive work; recognise and guarantee the rights of people who need care; and structure the coordination, functioning and competencies of public sector organisations.

Line of Action: Policies relating to youth, adolescence and childhood

Coordination and targeting strategy related to the Youth Impulse Mission policy in the Technical Secretariat's Lifetime Plan. It is supported by the elaboration of a coordination strategy for the existing policies focused on young people in extreme poverty, to generate and expand their employability opportunities, for both urban and rural youth. The strategy will be approached with a gender focus, to ensure that the policy promotes equal opportunities between men and women.



SHARING EXPERIENCES

EUROSociAL+ gathered seven Latin American countries and EU representatives in Lima at the regional workshop on gender equality policies, in order to coordinate national and regional perspectives on equality and gender equality plans. At the meeting, Ecuador shared its experience regarding its national gender equality plan.
